

Whiteboard Comic Book

Combine coding and robotics with storytelling to make comic books!

With the Class

- Break students into teams of 2-4. Instruct them to write a story that can be told in 4-8 frames. It must have a beginning, conflict, resolution and end.
- The team should work together to illustrate their story's frames on the whiteboard. The frames can include captions, speech bubbles and labels.
- Code Root to navigate through the frames and help tell the story. If using Level 2, students can use the Say Block to code Root to deliver lines.
- Let students present their stories to the class. To document, take a screenshot of students' code and a video of Root moving through the frames.
